Through the years, donors like you have provided care and support for our mission to end domestic violence. We are so grateful for your commitment to our organization. Because of you, we will celebrate our 40th anniversary on July 21, 2020. Leading up to that date, we have wonderful news to share about our ever-evolving organization, and we hope you are just as excited as we are!

What's happening in 2020?

- We are launching the South Suburban Domestic Violence Rapid-Rehousing Project, in collaboration with Crisis Center for South Suburbia, which will support more than 20 survivors with long-term housing solutions directly leading to sustainable safety! This is made possible by a \$584,000 grant from the Department of Housing and Urban Development.
- We are opening **Southside Connections: A Partnership between Apna Ghar and South Suburban Family Shelter**. With this new office, located on the southwest side of Chicago, we will be able to serve the Southland community better than ever.
- We are partnering with Senior Services Center of Will County to open a new Partner Abuse Intervention Program location in Will County, accomplishing a long standing goal for this program!
- We have gained a permanent new partner for our Medical Advocacy Program—Family Christian Health Center, located in Harvey, IL. We are ecstatic to add a new location to screen even more people for the presence of domestic violence in their lives.
